

The Stretton Strollers' Daffodil Run Wednesday 13th April 2022



On their Gatten Estate, high on the Stiperstones Hills, the Hulton-Harrop family planted 170,000 daffodil bulbs in Autumn 2015. These first flowered in Spring 2016 and they have provided a stunning annual display ever since. We have all had daffodils in our gardens for a few weeks now, but the Gatten Valley Daffodil Field is a North facing slope at an altitude of 1100 feet. This means that they flower later and should give us a good show when we visit on April 13th.

Of course, the daffodil is the symbol of the Marie Curie organisation which provides care and support for people living with any terminal illness across the UK. Their nurses work night and day in people's homes and their hospices offer specialist care.
